Bachelor of Arts Degree

Majors: Art, Art History, Classics (Ancient Studies, Classical Languages and Literature), Communication, English, History, Modern Languages (French, German, Italian, Spanish), Philosophy, Religious Studies, Performing Arts (Music, Theatre, Dance).

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 1A and 1B.
- 2) **Mathematics:** One course such as Math 1A, 1B, 10, or 11.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One lab science course such as Astronomy 10A/10L, 10B/10L; Biology 1A, 1B, 1C, 10, 13, 14, 15, 40A, 40B, 40C, 41; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 1C, 10, 12A, 12B, 12C, 25, 30A, 30B; Geography 1; Geology 10, 11; Meteorology 10/10L; Physics 2A, 2B, 2C, 4A, 4B, 4C, 4D, 10.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** Three courses from *one* of the following sequences: Art History 2A, 2B, 2C; History 4A, 4B, 4C.
- 5) **Math or Science:** One additional course in either subject area. The science course can be taken with or without a lab. Non-lab science courses are: Anthropology 1; Biology 9, 12, 45; Oceanography 10; Physics 6, 12
- 6) **Modern Languages:** Students must successfully complete the third course of the first year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 7) **Social Sciences:** One course such as Anthropology 2A, 2B, 3, 8; Economics 1A, 1B; Political Science 1, 2, 15; Psychology 1, 10, 30; Sociology 1, 15, 20, 40; Speech 10, 12.
- 8) **United States:** One course such as Art 11, 14; Drama 8; English 12, 31, 48A, 48B, 48C; History 17A, 17B; Music 8; Political Science 1, 7, 24; Speech 6.
- 9) **Ethnic/Women's Studies:** One course such as Anthropology 4, 5, 6; Art 2D, 2E, 11; Drama 8; English 5, 12, 22, 31, 41; History 8, 10, 20; Music 8; Political Science 7; Psychology 21, 22; Social Science 20; Sociology 21, 23; Speech 10, 12; Women's Studies 5, 11, 15, 21.
- 10) **World Cultures/Societies:** Two courses may be taken from the Area List or one each from the Area and Global Lists. **Area:** Anthropology 2A, 6; Art 12, 13; History 15, 18, 19, 23A; Philosophy 24. **Global:** Geography 2, 5, 10.
- 11) **Studio/Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses totaling three semester units, such as Art 4A, 4B, 4C, 4D, 4E, 5A, 5B, 6, 8, 19A, 19B, 19C, 20A, 20B, 37A, 37B, 37C, 39A, 39B, 39C, 43, 44, 45A, 45B, 45C, 45D, 45F, 47; Drama 20A, 20B, 20C, 20D, 20E; Music 10, 12A, 12B, 12C, 12D, 12E, 12F, 13A, 13B, 13C, 14A, 14B, 14C, 15A, 15B, 15C; Photography 1/1LX, 50; Video Arts 20, 21.
- 12) **Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a **third course in English Composition** are required, but count only if taken at Santa Clara University.

Bachelor of Science Degree

Majors: Anthropology, Biology, Chemistry, Combined Sciences, Economics, Engineering Physics, Environmental Sciences, Liberal Studies (Pre-Teaching), Mathematics and Computer Sciences, Physics, Political Science, Psychology and Sociology. *Please note: Students interested in majoring in Biology, Combined Sciences or Liberal Studies should refer to major-specific guides on the following pages.*

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 1A and 1B.
- 2) **Mathematics:** Math 1A and 1B. Sociology, Anthropology, and Political Science majors can choose to take two courses from Math 10, 11, and 12 instead. Psychology majors can choose to take Math 11 and 12.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One lab science course such as Astronomy 10A/10L, 10B/10L; Biology 1A, 1B, 1C, 10, 13, 14, 15, 40A, 40B, 40C, 41; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 1C, 10, 12A, 12B, 12C, 25, 30A, 30B; Geography 1; Geology 10, 11; Meteorology 10/10L; Physics 2A, 2B, 2C, 4A, 4B, 4C, 4D, 10.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 4) **Western Culture:** Two courses from one of the following sequences: Art History 2A, 2B, 2C; History 4A, 4B, 4C.
- 5) **Biological or Physical Science:** One additional course. The second science course can be taken with or without a lab. Non-lab science courses are: Anthropology 1; Biology 9, 12, 45; Oceanography 10; Physics 6, 12.
- 6) **Modern Languages:** **Bachelor of Science** students in the **Social Sciences** must successfully complete the **third course** of the first-year college-level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination. **Bachelor of Science** students majoring in **Natural Sciences or Mathematics** must successfully complete the **second course** of the first-year college-level sequence classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 7) **Social Sciences:** One course such as Anthropology 2A, 2B, 3, 8; Economics 1A, 1B; Political Science 1, 2, 15; Psychology 1, 10, 30; Sociology 1, 15, 20, 40; Speech 10, 12.
- 8) **United States:** One course such as Art 11, 14; Drama 8; English 12, 31, 40; English 48A, 48B, 48C; History 17A, 17B; Music 8; Political Science 1, 7; Speech 6.
- 9) **Ethnic/Women's Studies:** One course such as Anthropology 4, 5, 6; Art 2D, 2E, 11; Drama 8; English 5, 12, 22, 31, 41; History 8, 10, 20; Music 8; Political Science 7; Psychology 21, 22; Social Science 20; Sociology 21, 23; Speech 10, 12, 24; Women's Studies 5, 11, 15, 21.

Bachelor of Science Degree – Liberal Studies

The minimum required courses for admissions are:

- 1) **English:** English 1A and 1B.
- 2) **Mathematics:** Math 1A and 1B or Math 10 and 11.

Recommended courses to complete more of the University's Core Curriculum:

- 3) **Western Culture:** Two courses from **one** of the following sequences: Art History 2A, 2B, 2C; History 4A, 4B, 4C
- 4) **Modern Language:** Students must successfully complete the third course of the first year college- level sequence in a classical or modern foreign language or demonstrate an equivalent level of proficiency through examination.
- 5) **Social Science:** Political Science 1 and Psychology 1.
- 6) **United States:** History 17A
- 7) **World Cultures/Area:** Anthropology 2A
- 8) **World Cultures/Global:** Geography 10
- 9) **Performing Arts:** May be satisfied with a combination of courses in Performing Arts only totaling four quarter units, such as Drama 20A, 20B, 20C, 20D, 20E; Music 10, 12A, 12B, 12C, 12D, 12E, 12F, 13A, 13B, 13C, 14A, 14B, 14C, 15A, 15B, 15C;
- 10) **Biological/Physical Science with a Lab, Religious Studies, Ethics, Technology** and a third course in **English Composition** are required courses, but only count if taken at Santa Clara University.

Bachelor of Science Degree – Biology or Combined Sciences

The minimum required courses for admission are:

- 1) **English:** English 1A and 1B.
- 2) **Mathematics:** Math 1A and 1B.
- 3) **Biological or Physical Science:** One lab science course such as Chemistry 1A, 1B, 1C.

Recommended courses to complete for your major:

- 4) **Biological Sciences:** Biology 1A, 1B, 1C, 1D/1DL.
- 5) **Chemistry:** Chemistry 1A, 1B, 1C, 12A, 12B, 12C.
- 6) **Physics:** Physics 2A, 2B, 2C or 4A, 4B, 4C.

****Note:** It is recommended that you take the introductory Biology or general Chemistry sequence courses prior to taking the Physics series.
