1. Is PAMF in-network for Aetna OAMC HDHP (PPO)?
Yes, PAMF is in the OAMC HDHP network

2. Is PAMF in-network for Aetna HMO?
PAMF is in-network for Aetna HMO, but not Aetna AWH

3. Is a PCP referral needed for OB/GYN?
We confirmed and no, a PCP referral is not needed for an in-network OB/GYN provider.

5. Can Medicare Parts B & D premiums be paid for with HSA for spouse?
Yes, as long as **you** (employee) are over age 65.
