ACTIVATE YOUR DIGITAL CREDENTIAL



DIGITAL ACCESS CREDENTIAL

The digital ACCESS credential is available to all enrolled Santa Clara University students, and current faculty and staff. The convenience of your ACCESS Card is now available on your iPhone, Apple Watch or Android phone.

1. Tap and hold the back of mobile devices at a 45° angle at entrance Hotspot wall readers to update & grant entry and at residence hall door lock readers to grant entry.
2. Locks will pull your ACCESS information automatically. You do not need to open your mobile wallet.

UPDATE REGULARLY

Your ACCESS digital credential must be updated every 30 days by holding your device to any Hotspot wall reader on campus. If your credential is not granting entry, return to the nearest Hotspot to update, and try again!
