


MALLEY CENTER CHECK-IN DATA



DAILY USAGE




MONTHLY USAGE

FACILITY UPDATES



DIVIDER CURTAINS REPLACED

The courts were transformed with newly designed divider curtains with logos facing Courts 1 and 3.

POOL DECK REPAIR

Summer '23, the pool deck was sand blasted and a new surface adhered down.





POOL LOUNGE CHAIRS

Five additional lounge chairs were ordered for student users. We now have 25.

FACILITY UPDATES



WEIGHT ROOM CHANGES

The removal of 14 pieces of cardio and 3 plate loaded pieces made it possible to add more space for strength training and the increased number of users.

WEIGHT ROOM ADDITIONS

We added one treadmill and one stepmill to the weight room.





NEW STOOL STEPS IN LOCKER ROOMS

We added steps in the locker rooms at the sinks to make the area more accessible for our guests and patrons.

CLUB SPORTS

Club Sports introduced six new Club Sport Programs starting Fall 2023, increasing participation by 55.7% from the '22 - '23 academic year with the additional teams.

NOTABLE STATISTICS

- Bowling placed 8th overall in West Coast Regionals.
- **Boxing** had 3 of their athletes place Top 4 in the nation and became All-Americans.
- **Club Golf** won 5 out of the 6 NCCGA events that they competed in and placed 14th in the nation.
- Men's Club Baseball competed in their very first season as a club.
- **Men's Club Soccer** won the league and went undefeated their last 11 games.
- **Men's Ice Hockey** made playoffs for second straight year and had a record of 8-1.

CLUB SPORTS

NOTABLE STATISTICS CONTINUED

- Men's Ultimate Frisbee placed 8th at Regionals.
- **Men's Volleyball** placed Top 20 in National Competition and won League Championships for a second year in a row (first time in SCU history).
- Club Swimming had 3 of their athletes place Top 20 and one place Top 8 at National Championships.
- Club Tennis took gold in multiple tournaments throughout the year
- **Triathlon** finished 12th in conference and placed 33rd and Collegiate Nationals.
- Women's Club Soccer finished with a record of 8-1-1, placing first in league, and earned a promotion to premier league for next season.
- Women's Club Volleyball placed 4th in league and gold bracket at Far Westerns
- Women's Ultimate Frisbee attended Regionals.


