## A delegation of leaders from Santa Clara University and its Jesuit School of Theology visited Rome March 17-19 to meet with various senior Vatican leaders and leaders of the Society of Jesus.



The SCU delegation included:

- SCU Board of Trustees Chair Larry Sonsini and his wife Ashley Sonsini

"The purpose of the delegation's visit is to deepen ties and engage in wide-ranging discussions on global Jesuit higher education; the ethical use of artificial intelligence; advancing a synodal Church; and meeting the needs of the changing Catholic Church through theological education and formation.

The delegation discussed programming underway at Santa Clara's Jesuit School of Theology to advance the goals of Pope Francis's two-part Synod on Synodality. During this year between two Rome-based synod gatherings, JST is hosting, in collaboration with partners such as SCU's Division of Mission and Ministry, "Synodal Journey," a programmatic series featuring speakers and events to invite deep and meaningful discussions on key themes from the Synod.

On March 18, University President Julie Sullivan had a private audience with His Holiness Pope Francis.

Pope Francis "is an extremely joyful person who exudes an extraordinary light and magnetic human connection," said Sullivan. "I came away feeling so uplifted by who he is as a person and the way the Holy Spirit powerfully radiates from him," she added.

He urged President Sullivan to continue Santa Clara's focus on educating the entirety of each student.



"He's very expressive," Sullivan said of Pope Francis. "He was touching his head, his heart, and his hands. And he said often education is about filling the head. And it really needs to be about finding harmony between the head, the heart, and the hands," she said."
