3. You are responsible for reporting to the Student Services Office any change in the expected unit value of the course.
4. If you are beginning two Individual Research projects this term you should submit a separate copy of this form for each project.
5. If this course is dropped, the regular procedure for withdrawing from a course applies and must be followed.
6. **This course is graded on a Credit/No Credit basis only.**
7. To have an adjunct professor supervise your research, you first must obtain permission from Associate Dean for Academic Affairs.
